JUVENILE JUSTICE ADMINISTRATION

The Juvenile Justice Reform Act of 1996, as amended by House Substitute for Senate Bill 69, created the Juvenile Justice Authority. The Act required districts across the state to develop 5 Year Comprehensive Plans for the implementation of a full array of community based prevention and sanction services for juvenile offenders by July 1, 1999. After that date only serious violent and habitual juvenile offenders will be committed to the custody of the state for sentencing to a juvenile correctional facility. Effective July 1, 1997, the juvenile offenders previously in the custody of the State Department of Social and Rehabilitation Services (SRS), were transferred to the custody of the Juvenile Justice Authority. Services currently provided are case management, intensive supervision, truancy program and intake and assessment.
